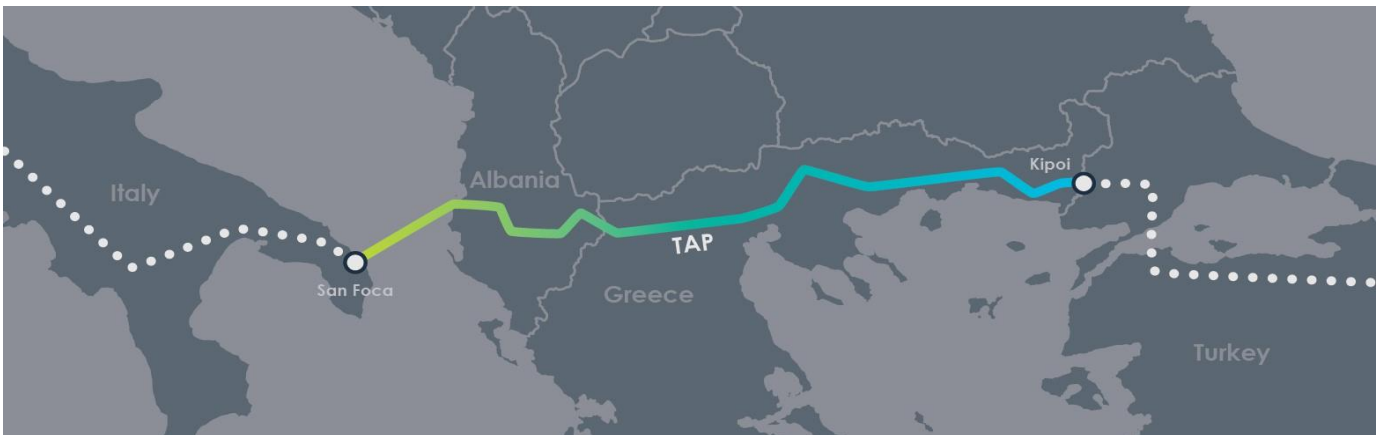

1. Introduction

This Cultural Heritage Management Procedure (CHMP) describes the requirements and best practices for avoidance, minimisation and mitigation of potential adverse impacts on cultural heritage during the operations phase to ensure compliance with TAP AG commitments and standards and applicable national and EU legislation.

This procedure is subordinate to and shall be read in conjunction with TAP AG Environmental and Social Management Manual (Ref. 1) which provides an overview of all TAP AG environmental, socio-economic and cultural heritage aspects and how impacts are identified, avoided, mitigated or managed in accordance with TAP AG commitments.

This procedure provides details of legal requirements, standards, policies, performance and compliance assurance of cultural heritage management.

This document contains requirements in addition to any legal requirements applicable to TAP AG (arising from national and/or EU legislation and the ESIA approvals in place), and therefore no such provision has any effect whatsoever on the fulfilment of these legal obligations by TAP AG. This document includes additional requirements formulated by, and incumbent on, TAP AG and, therefore, does not give any right to third parties and are not enforceable by any third party beyond any legal rights they may have in accordance with applicable laws.

1.1 Scope

This procedure is applicable to TAP AG owned and operated facilities in Greece, i.e. pipeline right of way (550 km) from the border between Greece and Turkey in Kipoi up to the border between Greece and Albania, including the compressor station at Kipoi and 24 block valve stations.

This procedure is applicable to all TAP AG employees and Operations and Maintenance (O&M) Contractors undertaking any dig ups and any other ground-breaking activities during operation phase of TAP Pipeline.

The scope of this procedure includes:

- Roles and responsibilities associated with implementation of this procedure (Section 1.4)
- Policy and legal framework (Section 3.1)
- Measures for impact avoidance and minimisation (Sections 3.2 - 3.7)
- An archaeological overview for TAP Pipeline (Section 3.8).

This document shall take effect from the commencement of commercial operations and shall supersede the previous construction phase Greece Cultural Heritage Management Plan (Ref. 2) and Cultural Heritage Contractor Control Plan (Ref. 3).

1.2 Purpose

The purpose of this procedure is to:

- present a clear framework of the tools and processes in place to manage cultural heritage during the operations phase in compliance with MOUs, as part of the Host Government Agreement (HGA) between the Hellenic Republic and TAP AG, in particular Schedules 4 and 5, and relevant standards of international financial institutions listed in Section 3.1
- to meet TAP AG obligations under the commitments of the approved TAP Environmental and Social Impact Assessments (ESIA) for Greece (Ref. 4) including subsequent approved amendments.

1.4 Roles and Responsibilities

1.4.1 Operations and Maintenance Country Manager

ESCH Management of hot commissioning activities, the introduction of hydrocarbons, the operation and maintenance of the TAP pipeline systems in each host country has been delegated to Operations and Maintenance Country Manager(s), who shall be responsible for:

- Cultural heritage management including protection of archaeological findings, coordinating compliance with and implementation of the laws for the protection of antiquities
- Ensuring implementation of ESCH controls outlined in Section 3 of this procedure.

1.4.2 O&M Engineer

TAP Operations and Maintenance Contractor(s) shall be responsible for:

- Informing the Land Team of any planned ground disturbance works and assessment of avoidance of known cultural heritage sites during internal planning of ground-breaking works
- Verifying that O&M Contractor has implemented mitigation measures required for the execution of ground-breaking works
- Ensuring implementation of chance find procedure by O&M Contractor and Field Archaeologist
- Investigation and reporting of cultural heritage incidents resulting in unplanned damage or impacts onto a CH site and ensuring repair of the damaged/impacted CH Site by O&M Contractor
- Ensuring reinstatement of CH site by O&M Contractor, and continuation of works following obtaining of the cultural heritage release documentation from competent authority.

1.4.3 O&M Contractor

This procedure assumes the following O&M personnel:

- Patrolling personnel – personnel performing RoW patrolling and routine non-intrusive inspections on foot and by on and off-road driving
- Site personnel – personnel undertaking RoW works.

TAP Operations and Maintenance Contractor(s) shall be responsible for:

- Acting in accordance with the relevant Maintenance contract in relation to cultural heritage management and this procedure
- Ensuring full compliance by all personnel and subcontractors with the provision of this procedure and applicable national legal requirements
- Engaging field archaeologist(s) when instructed to do so by TAP AG and the competent Ephorate, who are approved by the competent Ephorate for the execution of cultural heritage related works (e.g. monitoring) during ground-disturbing works
- Internal planning of ground-disturbance works, including completion of Pre-entry Checklist as per Land Entry Procedure (Ref. 6)

- Implementation of mitigation measures and chance find procedure (including stop work protocol) during execution of ground disturbance works when instructed to do so by the competent Ephorate
- Reporting any damage or impact on a cultural heritage site or resource in accordance with this procedure and, following instructions from the competent Ephorate, repairing any such damage and mitigating any impact to the satisfaction of the competent Ephorate and TAP AG using professional conservation specialists approved by the competent Ephorate
- Obtaining all necessary cultural heritage site release documentation from the competent Ephorate for ground disturbance works where competent Ephorate had been involved.

1.4.4 QHSE Officer

The QHSE Officer shall be responsible for:

- Supporting reporting and investigation of incidents related to unplanned impacts and/or damages to cultural heritage sites in accordance with QHSE Incident Reporting and Investigation Procedure (Ref. 7).

1.4.5 Field Archaeologist(s)

The role of the Field Archaeologist throughout this procedure assumes the representative(s) of a competent Ephorate or a person (or persons) engaged by the O&M Contractor on instruction from the competent Ephorate and approved by the competent Ephorate, for the execution of cultural heritage related works.

The Field Archaeologist(s) shall be responsible for:

- Engaging with and reporting to the competent Ephorate on the results of archaeological monitoring of ground disturbance works executed by the O&M Contractor including reporting of any chance finds encountered
- Maintaining archaeological monitoring and chance find documentation in accordance with this procedure
- Application of site treatment options and rescue excavations where specified by the competent Ephorate and in consultation with the competent Ephorate and with support of equipment and materials provided by the O&M Contractor
- Reporting any damage or impacts on a cultural heritage site or resource to the competent Ephorate and monitoring repair works arranged by the O&M Contractor to ensure they are undertaken in compliance with instructions from the competent Ephorate and to the satisfaction of the competent Ephorate and TAP AG
- Monitoring reinstatement of any known cultural heritage resources including sites of any chance finds encountered during the ground disturbance works to ensure completion of reinstatement to the satisfaction of competent Ephorate and TAP AG.

1.4.6 TAP Permitting Team

TAP Permitting Team shall be responsible for:

- -Reporting of any finds of historic human burials to local authority
- Reporting of finds of munitions or unexploded ordinance (UXO) and animal disease burial pits to civil and military authorities.

1.4.7 TAP Land Team

TAP Land Team shall be responsible for:

- Consultation with Greece Operations Phase Register of Cultural Heritage Constraints (Appendix 2) during internal planning of ground-breaking works
- Notifying competent authority (relevant Ephorate) of planned ground-breaking works
- Coordination of land exit on completion of O&M works as per Land Entry procedure (Ref. 6)
- Updating GIS and Greece Operations Phase Register of Cultural Heritage Constraints (Appendix 2) with any new CH information.

1.4.8 Competent Ephorate(s) of Antiquities

In compliance with MOUs, as part of the Host Government Agreement (HGA) between the Hellenic Republic and TAP AG (Schedules 4 and 5 in particular) the archaeological works including monitoring of ground disturbance works, rescue excavation, protection, maintenance and promotion of the findings shall be the sole responsibility of the competent Ephorates. In this respect, the competent Ephorate shall be solely responsible for the management, supervision and responsibility of all archaeological works, any associated scientific research and the care thereof, documentation, evaluation, storage, preservation, study, and publication of the findings.

The competent Ephorate may elect to appoint its representative for the execution of cultural heritage works (e.g. monitoring of ground disturbance works, rescue works) or may request TAP AG to engage services of a professional archaeologist(s) approved by the competent Ephorate. In the event of the latter, the field archaeologist(s) shall be engaged by the O&M Contractor on instruction from TAP AG and shall work according to the instructions and under the supervision of the competent Ephorate.

The competent Ephorate's responsibilities include the following:

- Specifying whether archaeological monitoring of the ground-breaking activities is required and if so, whether this shall be conducted by an Ephorate representative or provision of a field archaeologist(s) shall be arranged by TAP AG/O&M Contractor and approved by the competent Ephorate
- Specifying mitigation measures required for the ground-breaking activities (e.g. protection from vibration, dust, aesthetic impacts, etc.) as well as specifying mitigation measures required for a potential chance find (including stop work protocol)
- Confirming a potential chance find, assessing its significance and determining site treatment options or rescue excavation required
- Conducting chance find site treatment and rescue excavations, or undertaking supervision of these works where Field Archaeologist(s) is engaged on instruction from the competent Ephorate by TAP AG/O&M Contractor
- Specifying mitigation measures required for repairs of damage from vibrations and pollution and, where needed, seeking approval of these instructions from the Central Archaeological Council and the Directorate of Conservation of Ancient and Modern Monuments
- Approving the use of the professional conservators selected to perform the repair works and determining whether the repairs are sufficient or further works are required
- Providing cultural heritage site release documentation upon reinstatement of cultural heritage sites disturbed by TAP Operations.

3. Cultural Heritage Management Procedure

The process of cultural heritage management in Greece is presented in Appendix 1 to this document. Further detail on the process is provided in Section 3.1 – 3.9 of this procedure.

3.1 Policy and Legal Framework

TAP AG is committed to a number of environmental and social obligations, having adopted the following standards of international financial institutions such as:

- The European Bank of Reconstruction and Development (EBRD), specifically performance requirements 1 to 6, 8 and 10
- European Investment Bank (EIB) Environmental and Social Standards
- International Finance Corporation (IFC) Standards 1 to 6 and 8
- The Equator Principles
- The Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) Common Approaches.

These standards ensure that adverse impacts on people, their rights, livelihoods, culture and environment are avoided or, where avoidance is not possible, minimized, offset and/or compensated. The TAP AG is committed to its compliance and demonstration of Good Industry Practice (GIP) as a requirement of lender agreements with international financial institutions.

TAP AG shall be responsible to ensure that during ground disturbance activities associated with TAP operations, any resulting archaeological excavations comply with:

- applicable national legislation
- the Host Government Agreement (HGA) between the Hellenic Republic and the TAP AG
- international lender standards and policies
- specific requirements and commitments within the ESIA Greece (Ref. 4)
- requirements of this document.

3.2 Step 1: Internal Planning of Ground Disturbance Works

Cultural heritage resources shall be considered and included in any TAP operational activity that involves ground disturbance with a potential to impact cultural heritage sites, such as dig-ups, excavations, earth moving and any other ground-breaking activity.

All cultural heritage locations identified during the construction phase have been marked with brief details regarding their nature and extend within Zone A and Zone B on the GIS. A summary of the known cultural heritage locations identified during the construction stage is provided in the Greece Operations Phase Register of Cultural Heritage Constraints (Appendix 2 to this document).

In Greece cultural heritage was excavated within the pipe trench, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the MoU(s) signed between TAP AG and the competent Ephorates as well as the MoU between TAP AG and the Ministry of Culture and Sports. Therefore, any ground-breaking activity outside of the pipe trench undertaken in areas of the known/identified cultural heritage may encounter more findings.

Some cultural heritage sites have been protected within zones A and B and these geo-referenced areas, listed in Greece Operations Phase Register of Cultural Heritage Constraints (Appendix 2), shall be avoided whenever possible.

Where it is not possible to avoid monuments or cultural heritage sites, options shall be discussed with relevant stakeholders. Any discussion with stakeholders shall be conducted in accordance with the Stakeholder Engagement Procedure (Ref. 5)

TAP Land Entry Procedure (Ref. 6) shall be implemented prior to land entry undertaken as part of TAP Operations.

O&M Contractor Deliverables:

- Land Entry Checklist: As required under Land Entry Procedure (Ref. 6) Land Entry Checklist shall be completed.
- Implement avoidance: following assessment by TAP O&M Engineer, avoidance of known cultural heritage sites shall be implement where possible and/or practical.

TAP Land Team Deliverables:

- Cultural Heritage check prior to Land Entry: As required under Land Entry Procedure (Ref. 6), as part of the Land Entry Checklist completion, the Greece Operations Phase Register of Cultural Heritage Constraints (Appendix 2) and the GIS shall be consulted for location specific information in advance of any land entry that envisages ground disturbance.

TAP O&M Engineer Deliverables:

- Assessment of avoidance: All reasonable efforts shall be taken to avoid or minimise negative impacts to known cultural heritage resources. These shall include, where possible, undertaking measures to adjust the siting of the activity to avoid physical damage to monuments and archaeological sites, and, if applicable, sites with intangible cultural heritage (ICH) value. Geo-referenced areas listed in Greece Operations Phase Register of Cultural Heritage Constraints (Appendix 2) shall be avoided whenever possible.
- External Notifications: TAP Land Team shall be advised to carry out notification to the competent Ephorate prior of any ground-breaking activity.

3.3 Step 2: External Notification and Feedback

TAP Land Team Deliverables:

- Notification to competent Ephorate: Prior to start of any ground-breaking activity, a notification on land entry date shall be made to the competent Ephorate along with provision of any required documentation. The notification shall include the schedule of works, location of the affected area and depth of envisaged ground disturbance.

Competent Ephorate Deliverables:

- Feedback on Mitigation and Archaeological Monitoring: The competent Ephorate specifies the mitigation measures required for the ground-breaking activities (e.g., protection from vibration, dust, aesthetic impacts, etc.). The competent Ephorate also specifies whether archaeological monitoring of the ground-breaking activities is required and if so, whether this will be conducted by an Ephorate representative or provision of an archaeologist(s) shall be arranged by TAP AG.

TAP O&M Engineer Deliverables:

- Feedback on Mitigation and Archaeological Monitoring: Mitigation measures and archaeological monitoring requirements specified by the competent Ephorate shall be communicated to the O&M Contractor(s).

O&M Contractor Deliverables:

- Mitigation planning: Mitigation measures specified by the Ephorate shall be planned for in advance for ground disturbance activities.
- Archaeological Monitoring of ground disturbance activities: Where specified by the competent Ephorate an archaeologist(s) shall be arranged to be present for any ground-breaking work.
- Stakeholder engagement: O&M Contractor shall ensure that all stakeholders are consulted prior to any mitigation that could limit the public and private use of cultural heritage sites such as covering it as part of protection from dust and other forms of stone pollution, deviating access pathways, repairing or restoring any structural or aesthetic damage.

3.4 Step 3: Execution of Ground-breaking Works

Known cultural heritage sites listed in Greece Operations Phase Register of Cultural Heritage Constraints (Appendix 2) shall be protected from damage during TAP Operations. Sites may be located on the pipeline Zone B, adjacent to the right of way or in its close proximity, and in some cases be located in Zone A.

O&M Contractor Deliverables:

- Implementation of mitigation measures: Mitigation measures listed in Operations Phase Register of Cultural Heritage Constraints (Appendix 1) shall be implemented during dig ups and ground-breaking activities (e.g. such as fencing, signage, dust control, or ensuring public access to specific areas) upon consultation and approval by the competent Ephorate.
- Protection from vibration: If the structural assessment undertaken by TAP AG indicates that a site is at risk of impacts from vibration, the O&M Contractor after consultation and approval by the competent Ephorate shall ensure that the site will be structurally reinforced or otherwise stabilized, and appropriate measures are taken to avoid, or where this is not possible, minimise any possible damage that may occur.
- Protection from dust and other forms of stone pollution: If TAP AG structural assessment indicates a risk of impacts from pollution, the O&M Contractor shall cover or otherwise protect the site from potential impacts upon consultation and approval by the competent Ephorate. If dust from earthworks is an issue the O&M Contractor shall ensure that appropriate measures are taken to avoid, or where this is not possible, minimise any possible damage that may occur due to its activities.
- Protection from negative aesthetic impacts: The aesthetic techniques considered for implementation by the O&M Contractor shall include noise-reducing barriers, low-profile constructions, proper sighting and location to maximize the use of topography and vegetation, screening, blending with topographic forms and existing vegetation patterns and use of environmental coloration or advanced camouflage techniques to limit visual effects.
- Dig up and other ground-breaking techniques: The O&M Contractor shall use appropriate excavation techniques to avoid known cultural heritage sites, or where this is not possible, minimise, any possible damage that may occur due to its activities.

TAP RoW Manager Deliverables:

- Verification of mitigation measures: Implementation of mitigation measures by the O&M Contractor prior to start of ground disturbance activities shall be verified.

Field Archaeologist Deliverables:

- Reporting on ground disturbing activities: Ground disturbance monitoring activities shall be documented and reported regularly by the Field Archaeologist to the competent Ephorate and to TAP AG.

3.5 Step 4: Chance Find Procedure

A Chance Finds Procedure is required by the international standards listed in Section 3.1.

A Chance Finds Procedure detailed within this section shall be implemented for all dig up and any other ground-breaking activities and applied in the event of encountering any movable or immovable objects, sites, structures or groups of structures having archaeological, paleontological, historical, architectural, religious, aesthetic or other cultural significance. This procedure provides for the monitoring of ground disturbance activities by professional archaeologist(s) engaged by TAP AG or by the O&M Contractor or another entity nominated by TAP AG and approved by competent Ephorates, and the commitment to temporarily stop work in the vicinity of any new archaeological discovery. Upon discovery of a chance find, the O&M Contractor activities shall resume only after the Ephorate-approved avoidance, minimisation or mitigation measures have been implemented. The objective of the chance find procedure is to protect previously unrecorded cultural heritage sites, objects or features from operations-related damage. The chance find procedure applies to potential cultural heritage objects, features or sites identified as a result of construction activities or from archaeological trial trench investigations.

The management of any chance find shall be handled in accordance with applicable Greek law and standards outlined in Section 3.1.

O&M Contractor Deliverables:

- Suspension of works and reporting of chance finds: upon encounter of any suspected chance find, the work shall be suspended and the find shall be immediately reported to the Field Archaeologist monitoring the ground-breaking activity
- Stop work protocol and protection of chance find area: Works in the area of the chance find shall temporarily stop and the area shall be marked for avoidance until further assessment is conducted by the competent Ephorate. Where a chance find is confirmed as cultural heritage resource by the competent Ephorate, work shall cease, unless otherwise instructed by the competent Ephorate and further instructions shall be provided by the competent Ephorate regarding mitigation measures and/or treatment work.
- Provision of equipment: The O&M Contractor shall provide all equipment and material necessary for site treatment options, trial trench and rescue excavations specified by the competent Ephorate and conducted by the Field Archaeologist under the supervision of the competent Ephorate.
- Re-start of works: Site works shall resume only after the implementation of mitigation measures and/or treatment work approved by competent Ephorate or the Central Archaeological Council, as the case may be.

Field Archaeologist Deliverables:

- Reporting of the chance find: The discovery of any potential chance find shall be reported to the competent Ephorate. In addition, chance finds of human burials, munitions or unexploded ordnance (UXO) and animal disease burial pits shall be left undisturbed and reported to the TAP Permitting Team as well.
- Chance Find Report: Where a chance find is confirmed as cultural heritage resource by the competent Ephorate, a Chance Find Report shall be completed by the Field Archaeologist in collaboration with the competent Ephorate and submitted to the relevant Ephorate and TAP RoW Manager. This report shall contain the following information:
 - date and time of the discovery
 - location of the discovery (GPS coordinates and KP reference)

- description of the discovery
- characterization of the nature of the find i.e. movable / non movable

- recommendation on how to proceed
- temporary protection measures implemented.
- Monitoring and Chance Find Documentation: The following records shall be maintained by the Field Archaeologist:
 - daily monitoring records indicating areas and activities monitored, reported chance finds and the results of any evaluations. Communications and instructions (such as stop work and resume work) shall also be included
 - weekly reports summarizing reporting period activities including chance finds, assessments and evaluations, internal and external communications and instructions and supporting photographic documentation (or other reference materials as appropriate). Additional reports aimed at fulfilling any specific TAP AG requirements or requests from MoC for the work may be anticipated
 - monthly reports summarizing monitoring and evaluation results, status of any site treatment measures applied, instructions to O&M Contractor, and other internal and external communications.
- Site Treatment: Site treatment options decided by the competent Ephorate (subject to approval by the Central Archaeological Council, if needed) such as preservation in place through rerouting or specialized construction techniques, and rescue excavations in advance of additional ground-disturbing work, if avoidance is not possible, shall be applied by the Field Archaeologist according to the instructions and under the supervision of the competent Ephorate.
- Rescue Excavations: Rescue excavations shall be conducted in accordance with the decision of the competent Ephorate, and by MoCS, where required. The work shall be undertaken by Field Archaeologist as per the instructions and under the supervision of the competent Ephorate. The rescue excavations shall be implemented according to the relevant MoU to be signed for this purpose between the competent Ephorate and TAP AG, substantially in the form of Schedule 4 of the HGA.

Competent Authority Deliverables:

- Decision on suspension/resumption of works: On receiving a notification from the Field Archaeologist regarding a potential chance find site, the competent Ephorate decides whether the work should be suspended and specifies mitigation measures for implementation prior to works being resumed. Upon satisfaction that mitigation measures have been implemented, the competent Ephorate will approve resumption of works.
- Confirmation of the chance find: The decision on whether a chance find is a cultural heritage resource requiring additional treatment is made by the competent Ephorate.
- Assessment of the confirmed chance find: The competent Ephorate verifies its significance with cooperation and support from TAP AG and decides on site treatment options and/or further action required. Such actions may include, but not be limited to:
 - removal, if feasible, of artefact(s)/cultural site(s) deemed to be of high or moderate significance

- execution of further excavation within a specified distance of the discovery point of site(s) deemed to be of high significance
- decision / release letter of instruction to continue with the ground-disturbing work.

TAP Permitting Team Deliverables:

- Finds of historic human burials: Where the Field Archaeologist is convinced of the ancient origin of human burials, such discoveries and a professional assessment of their age shall be reported to the local authority.
- Finds reportable to Civil Authorities: Finds of munitions or unexploded ordnance (UXO) and animal disease burial pits shall be reported to Civil and Military Authorities.

3.6 Step 5: Unplanned Damage or Impact on Cultural Heritage Resources

O&M Contractor Deliverables:

- Unplanned impact / damage avoidance: Every effort shall be made to avoid impacts to known or chance find cultural heritage resources.
- Stopping work where impact occurs: Where an impact occurs to a cultural heritage resource and relevant instruction has been received from the competent Ephorate to suspend the work, the mitigation measures specified by the competent Ephorate shall be implemented and work shall not resume until approval to do so has been received from the competent Ephorate.
- Repair of damages from vibration: In the event all or part of a cultural heritage site is damaged due to excessive vibration the Field Archaeologist shall be notified immediately, who shall in turn, notify the TAP RoW Manager and the competent Ephorate. Upon the competent Ephorate's instructions building conservators shall be engaged immediately, and any necessary action shall be undertaken to repair the structure with conventional conservation techniques to the satisfaction of the competent Ephorate and TAP AG.
- Repair of damages from pollution: In the event a site of cultural value is damaged due to pollution, the Field Archaeologist shall be notified immediately, who shall in turn, notify the TAP RoW Manager and the competent Ephorate. Upon the competent Ephorate's instructions, the site shall be cleaned by professional conservators approved by the competent Ephorate and any necessary action shall be undertaken to clean the pollution damage to satisfaction of the competent Ephorate and TAP AG.

Field Archaeologist Deliverables:

- Reporting of impacts / damages: Any observed impacts to cultural heritage shall be reported by the Field Archaeologist to TAP O&M Engineer and to the competent Ephorate, who may stop work until inspection and mitigation measures are established. This requirement is applicable to impacts on cultural heritage sites within all areas potentially affected by the TAP Operations.

Competent Ephorate Deliverables:

- Decision on suspension/resumption of works: On receiving a notification from the Field Archaeologist regarding damage / impact to a cultural heritage site, the competent Ephorate decides whether the work should be suspended and specifies mitigation measures for implementation prior to works being resumed. Upon satisfaction that mitigation measures have been implemented, the competent Ephorate will approve resumption of works.

- Repairs of damage from vibrations and pollution: In the event all or part of a cultural heritage site is damaged due to excessive vibration or pollution, the competent Ephorate will issue instruction on necessary actions to be implemented and, where needed, seek approval of these instructions from the Central Archaeological Council and the Directorate of Conservation of Ancient and Modern Monuments. The competent Ephorate may also approve the use of the professional conservators selected by the O&M Contractor to perform the repair works. Upon completion of the repairs, the competent Ephorate in cooperation with TAP AG will determine whether the repairs are sufficient or further work is required.

TAP O&M Engineer Deliverables:

- Reporting and investigation of incidents involving cultural heritage: In the event damage is caused to a suspected cultural heritage asset, any ongoing works that may pose a risk of further damage shall be suspended, and the damage shall be reported as cultural heritage incident in accordance with QHSE Incident Reporting and Investigation Procedure (Ref. 7).

3.7 Step 6: Reinstatement of Cultural Heritage Site

O&M Deliverables:

- Reinstatement of cultural heritage site: The site of any known cultural heritage resources including sites of any chance finds encountered during the ground disturbance works shall be reinstated under the supervision of the Field Archaeologist to the satisfaction of the competent Ephorate and TAP AG.
- Cultural Heritage Release Documentation and continuation of works: Prior to continuation of ground disturbing activities and where competent Ephorate had been involved in ground-disturbance works, all necessary cultural heritage site release documentation shall be obtained from the competent Ephorate for any cultural heritage work undertaken.

Field Archaeologist Deliverables:

- Reinstatement of cultural heritage site: Reinstatement of any known cultural heritage resources including sites of any chance finds encountered during the ground disturbance works shall be monitored to ensure completion of reinstatement to the satisfaction of competent Ephorate and TAP AG.

TAP Land Team Deliverables:

- Land Exit Protocol: Land exit protocol outlined in the Land Entry Procedure (Ref. 6) shall be followed on completion of ground-disturbance works.
- Update of GIS and Greece Operations Phase Register of CH Constraints (Appendix 2): The GIS database and Greece operations Phase Register of CH Constraints (Appendix 2) shall be updated with information of any new chance find or work completed in the areas with known cultural heritage resources.

3.8 Compliance Monitoring and Reporting

Cultural heritage management compliance indicators listed in Appendix 3 shall be reported in accordance with Section 3.4.4 of the ESMM (Ref. 1).

3.9 Archaeological Work overview, Scope and Guidance

The following is specific guidance on the level of work to be undertaken. The work, including any trial trench investigations and Chance Find rescue excavation work, shall be undertaken by archaeologists engaged by the O&M Contractor or another entity to be nominated by TAP AG, who shall work under the management and supervision of the competent Ephorate. The O&M Contractor will supply all the necessary equipment that, as per the MOU, will be requested by the competent Ephorate. Archaeological trial trench investigations and Chance Find rescue excavation work shall be the responsibility of the competent Ephorate.

The management of TAP cultural heritage features followed a phased approach to the progressive identification of sites and impacts during the design and construction of the TAP Pipeline. In advance of the construction of the pipeline, there were five phases. As the construction work for the 10 bcma case has been completed and Zone A and Zone B have been established, only Phase 4 and Phase 5 below shall be applicable for Operations. Should any new work be undertaken that was not considered during the ESIA, then all phases below shall need to be applied. The 5 phases are as discussed below.

3.9.1 Phase 1: Review of the existing data

Areas of potential archaeological interest were initially identified by desk-based activities such as scientific literature review, documentary searches for previous archaeological work and examination of aerial and satellite images and have now been augmented from the construction work and the identification of unknown chance finds (CH Sites).

3.9.2 Phase 2: Extensive and intensive surveys

The route of the pipeline and facilities was examined on the ground to assist in the determination of potential impact and to define the parameters of the further investigation. Areas of potential impact lying within the pipeline construction corridor (38m) or which might be impacted by permanent or temporary facilities (such as access roads and construction camps) were examined through focused field investigations to determine their nature and significance. This was done by various means including detailed survey, geophysical survey and trial trenching. The information was used to assist in the detailed design of the pipeline route and facilities and where possible, the route was changed, or its impact reduced to minimise the damage to cultural heritage features.

Sites requiring work in this phase were identified in the ESIA (Ref. 4).

3.9.3 Phase 3: Pre-construction excavations

In areas where damage to the resource was unavoidable, archaeological deposits were recorded by a planned rescue excavation prior to construction activities. Phase 3 investigations involved archaeological data recovery, in which cultural data was recovered from the sites in the form of artefacts and recording of soils and features. Phase 3 investigation of a site resulted in a scientific report accompanied by artefacts prepared for museum curation. Phase 3 work therefore reflected a form of mitigation of Project impacts to such archaeological sites. An alternative mitigation measure was site avoidance by rerouting of the pipeline route, or re-design of facilities.

3.9.4 Phase 4: Chance Finds

It is recognised that maintenance of the pipeline and associated permanent and temporary facilities may reveal previously unknown archaeological features. Arrangements shall be made for the monitoring of operations ground disturbance works and provision of a team of archaeologists to conduct 'rescue/salvage excavations' where required. This is also known as the "Chance Finds Procedure" (see Section 3.5). The discovery of Chance Finds can lead to rescue excavations to mitigate impacts. Rescue excavations shall be

conducted in accordance with the provisions of the relevant MoUs that are to be entered into (for this purpose) between the competent ephorate and TAP AG, which shall be substantially in the form of schedule 4 of the HGA.

3.9.5 Phase 5: Study of Material and Reporting

This phase includes the dissemination of results of the work both to the archaeological audience and to the wider public via an appropriate medium. Standards of work shall comply with Greek national standards listed in Section 3.1.

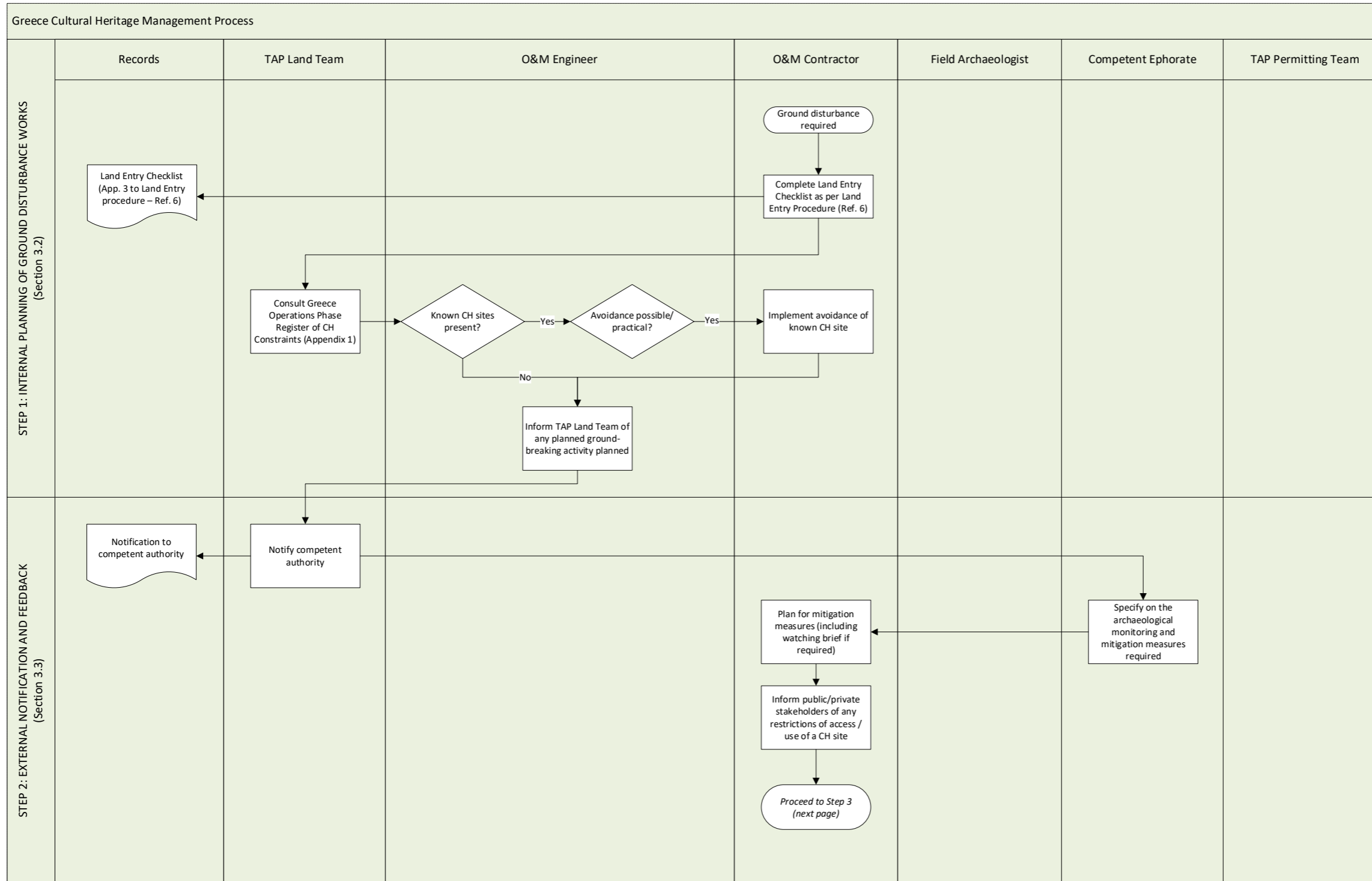

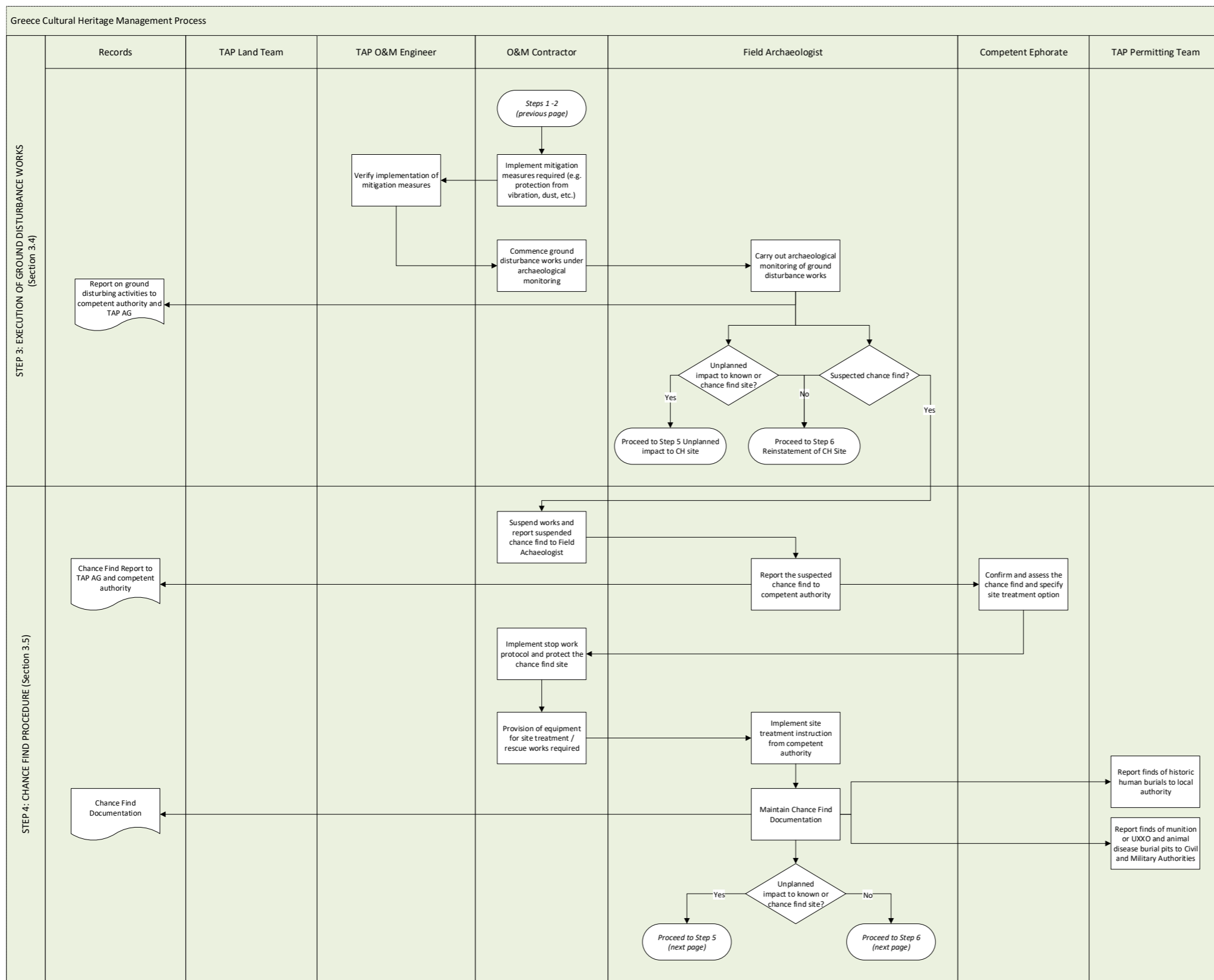
Appendix 1 Greece Cultural Heritage Management Process

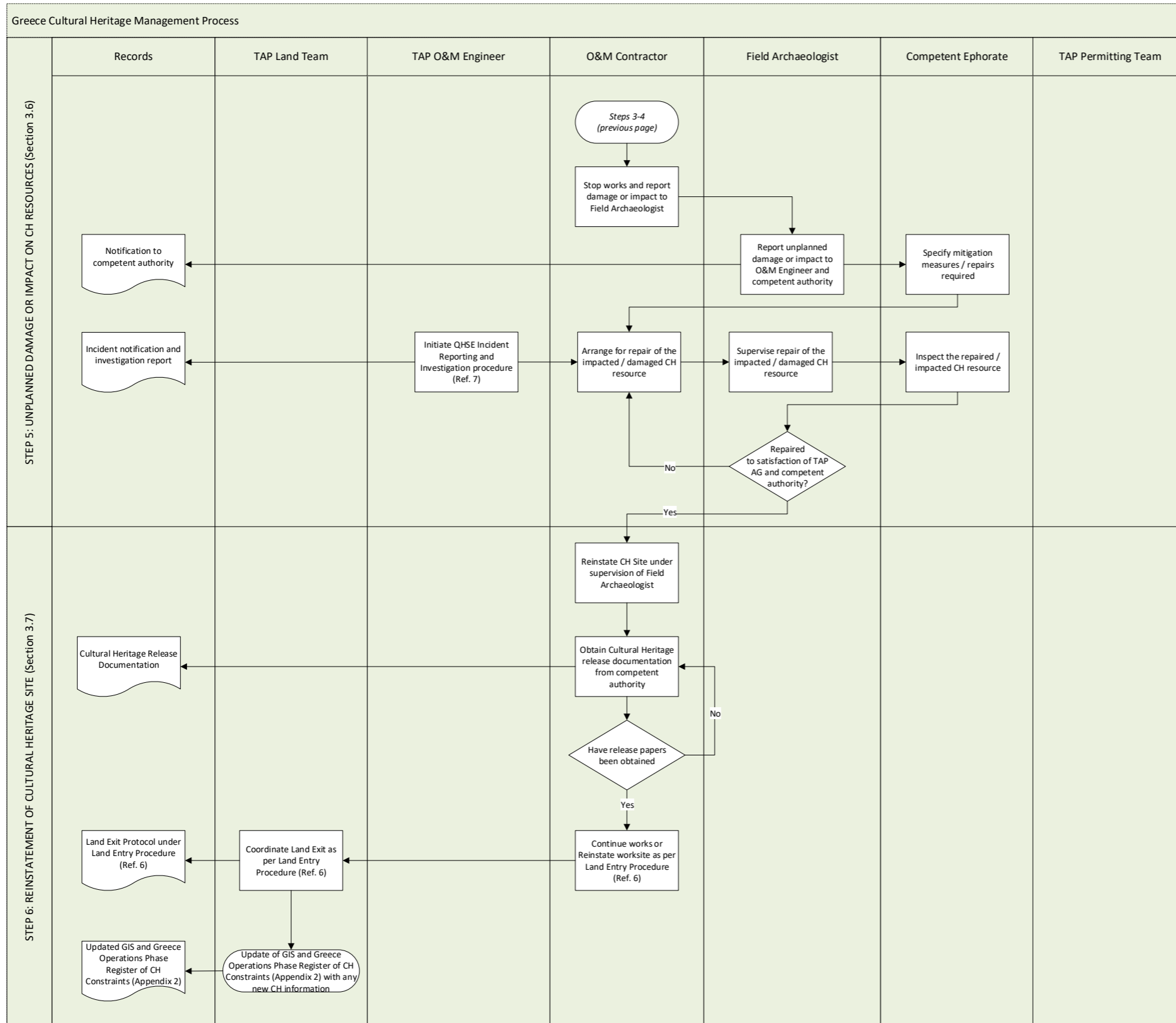
